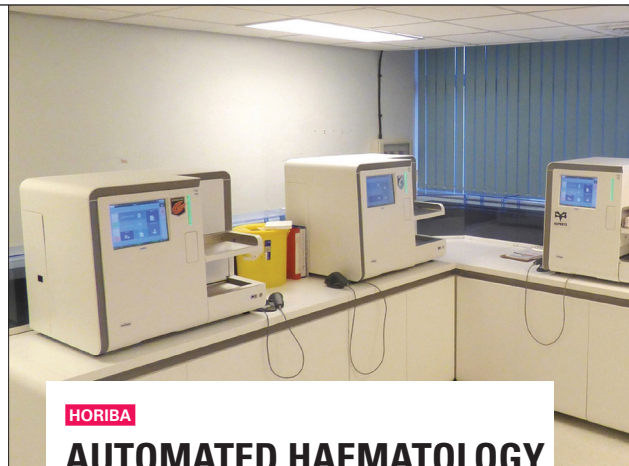
POCT ANALYSER

EKF Diagnostics' FDA-cleared DiaSpect point-of-care testing haemoglobin analyser has been used to study iron-deficient anaemia in a remote region of Ghana, West Africa.

A small team working in a village established that anaemia is very common among women of childbearing age, leading to blood transfusions and, more commonly, death.

They used the analyser to measuring haemoglobin in order to confirm the prevalence of anaemia.
